## LETTER FROM YOUR BOARD PRESIDENT

Dear Petroleum Club Members,

I am writing to inform you of some recent decisions made by your Petroleum Club Board. These decisions were presented at the Annual Stockholders Meeting April 30. In the event you missed the meeting, please review as follows:

The Club voted to expand the current club configuration to include a \$3.5 MM ballroom addition at last year's Stockholders meeting. This ballroom addition was to be used to host events to replace the venue we lost when our lease was not renewed at Le Pavillon. When the final bids came in for this project, they originally exceeded \$4MM. The board began reviewing financials for the Club, as well as experiencing this current downturn in the oilfield and we decided to put the ballroom project on hold at least to the end of this year and make sure the Club can maintain itself with the campus we currently have before considering this expansion again.

John O'Meara and his staff have done a great job making cuts in their everyday work budget to work through this. We have had some increases in the prices of plates, service charges and an increase in Capital Expenditure charges. With all of these changes, we are looking at a budget going forward to stay in the black.

Please continue to enjoy your Club. We have traditional Bingo every other Thursday, Friday night dancing, a Sunday buffet second to none, Early Bird and Steak night on Wednesdays and Specialty Dinners on certain Thursdays. We have added Wine and Dine Wednesdays in the lounge with piano music to come meet your fellow Club members and enjoy some relaxing music. Of course, there continues to be the lunch buffet every weekday to get in and have an enjoyable lunch in a first class atmosphere.

The Club sends out an e-blast every Monday morning with all weekly events outlined. 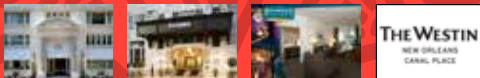
